## **DETAILS / INFORMATION**

## Subsea Obstruction – Tie in arrangement

There is a Tie-in arrangement connected to the ongoing pipe laying from DAS ISLAND to RAS AL QILA. The height of the Tie In is 4m above the seabed at the position LAT 24° 49'.89 N, LONG 052° 53'.60E.

A new **Isolated Danger Buoy**, named "*<u>Tie-in</u>", BRB, Fl(2)*, has been deployed in position LAT 24° 49.890N, LONG 052° 53.585E, to mark this subsea obstruction.

All Ships are advised to keep well clear from the subject location, and navigate with extra caution at a safe speed.

**CAUTION:** All Ships are advised to maintain a listening watch on VHF channels VHF 9 (Port Control) and VHF 21 (VTIS).
