**To Project Contractors & Project Craft Community
Port Operations**

Entry / Exit Procedures for Project Crafts

1. All Projects crafts (boats & barges) should use the YABR channel for transiting in & out the port.
2. Permission should be obtained from the Ruwais Port Control on VHF Ch No. 09 prior entering/departing.
3. All projects crafts will be escorted by Port craft from East Ghasha to Project Site No Go Area and vise-versa, regardless of their cargo.
4. Port entry, departure and transit shall be carried out only during **Daylight**.
5. While navigating in or out of YABR channel, position report should be given to the Ruwais Port Control at the following buoys as per the standard passage plan.
 - East Ghasha
 - North Yabr
 - Yabr Channel
 - South Yabr Channel
6. All crafts should keep well clear from and give way to tanker vessels.
7. Ruwais Port Control instructions should be promptly adopted while navigating at the inner anchorage.
8. Self-Propelled barges shall not be allowed to navigate within the port limits under their own power.
